Elections:

Currently two individuals have pulled and returned candidate papers to run for City Mayor, those individuals are Tony Cardenas and Douglas Hatley Jr. Five individuals have pulled candidate papers for City Council; four have returned the papers for official filing, those individuals are John Leach, Jose De Jesus Valerio Martinez "Chuy", Thomas Woodall and Robert Snow. Candidate papers were pulled and returned by Laura Calkins (City Treasurer) and Lisa Linnet (City Clerk).

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Streetscape Project Update:

The Contractor will begin sidewalk demolition on the south side of Solano Street between 6th and West Street mid-August. New sidewalks and tree wells will be installed to the west end of the Super Shopper Auto Dealer. Once the Contractor begins installation of the new sidewalk on the south side of Solano Street he will then begin sidewalk demolition on the north side of Solano.

The Contractor intends to prepare the Sixth Street traffic signalization to incorporate the left turn signal (directional arrow) next week.

PG&E:

PG&E has informed the Public Works Department that they will be in town this week performing a routine Leak Survey of their main lines. Their vehicles will be marked with the PG&E logos.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 173 calls for service, a total of 24 officer reports were taken and there were 66 officer-initiated incidents, including 18 traffic stops. Officers made 7 misdemeanor arrests and 2 felony arrests. Officers issued 17 citations, of which; 7 were misdemeanors, 1 was a felony, 1 was an infraction, 7 were parking-related, and 1 was unclassified during the period of August 3, 2016 through August 10, 2016.
