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### **HOLIDAYS:**

**Presidents' Day:** Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup> City Hall, the City Finance Department, and the City Corporation Yard (Public Works) will be closed.

### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **City Manager's Department Meeting:**

I will be out of the office February 6-10<sup>th</sup> attending a City Manager's Conference.

#### **FY 2015/2016 Audit Financial Statements:**

The FY 2015/2016 Financial Statements will be presented to the City Council at its February 14<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting.

#### **City Utility Billing Statements:**

City utility customers will now receive utility billing in a full page format. This new format also allows the City to insert public information flyers into our billing and will increase our outreach to City residents.

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Meeting with AirCon Energy regarding possible Energy Efficiency Project:**

Assistant Public Works Director Steve Lindeman met with Andy Roth, AirCon Energy, Inc., on February 8<sup>th</sup> for a walk through of City owned facilities. Mr. Roth collected information during his visit that would assist him in providing the City with a plan to provide potential energy savings costs to the City by making improvements to the City's current lighting and equipment. Mr. Roth indicated that if he needed any further information that he would be in contact with City Manager Kristina Miller.

#### **City Street Signs:**

In February 2011, Council approved Resolution 02-08-2011-03 adopting a street sign standard that was incorporated into the City of Corning Construction Specifications and Standard Details for Public Works Projects. The signs are not holding up very well as there is apparent fading after only a few years' time has passed. It is not cost effective to continue to order the signs under the current standard until the fading issue can be resolved by the manufacturer. The Public Works department will not be ordering street signs under the current standard until the street sign issue can be re-addressed and presented to Council at a City Council Meeting.

**Tehama County Multi-Jurisdiction Mitigation Plan Update:**

Tehama County Flood Control & Water Resource Manager Ryan Teubert invited Public Works Director Dawn Grine to participate on an interview panel of the top two ranking consultants for the Multi-Jurisdiction Mitigation Plan Update. The interview was held at Tehama County Public Works via phone conference with Dynamic Planning + Service; Oakland, CA and then with Tetra Tech, Inc.; also of Oakland, CA. The interview panel consisted of Dawn Grine, City of Corning; Carolyn Steffan City of Tehama; Scott Miller, City of Red Bluff and Ryan Teubert Tehama County.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 204 calls for service, a total of 30 officer reports were taken and there were 89 officer-initiated incidents, including 26 traffic stops. Officers made 6 misdemeanor arrests and 4 felony arrests. Officers issued 15 citations, of which; 8 were misdemeanors, 4 were infractions, 2 were parking-related, and 1 was animal-related during the period of February 1, 2017 through February 8, 2017.
