CITY MANAGER:

Sales Tax Measure Ordinance No. 663,

A second reading of the Ordinance that places a ½ cent sales tax measure on the June 7th ballot will be considered at the February 23rd City Council meeting. This is the last action the City Council must take to place the item on the ballot.

As of February 10, 2015 there are 2,571 registered voters in the City of Corning. The political subdivision is as follows:

Mayor Gary Strack and I met with members of the Corning Police Officers' Association and a few Dispatchers to ensure they understand what is being proposed as part of the sales tax measure.

Mid-Year Budget Presentation:

The Mid-Year Budget Update will be given at the March 8th City Council meeting.

Preparation of a Business Incentives and Resources Guide:

I will be preparing a 'Business Incentives and Resources Guide' to recruit businesses to the City of Corning. The Guide will be sent to known businesses looking to expand in California. Business recruitment, retention, and expansion are crucial to expand our sales tax base. With Council direction, I hope to further work with the Corning Chamber of Commerce in these efforts.

Pharmaceutical Drug Disposal:

The Corning Police Department and I are pursuing a plan to accept unwanted pharmaceutical drugs from the public every day. These efforts will help reduce unintended access, overdose, and addiction to pharmaceuticals in our community by providing an option for proper disposal.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 194 calls for service, a total of 41 officer reports were taken and there were 116 officer-initiated incidents, including 61 traffic stops. Officers made 15 misdemeanor arrests and 3 felony arrests, and issued 31 citations of which 18 were misdemeanors, 10 were infractions, 1 was a felony, 1 was parking-related and 1 was unclassified during the period of February 10, 2016 through February 17, 2016.
