### SCHEDULES:

**February 6, 2016 Annual Chamber Dinner:** The Annual Chamber Dinner is on Saturday, February 6, 2016 at the Corning Veteran's Memorial Hall (1620 Solano St.) with the "No Host Reception" beginning at 6 p.m. followed by the dinner at 7 p.m.

### CITY MANAGER:

#### **Animal Shelter Tour:**

Council member Tony Cardenas, Lisa Linnet, and I toured the Corning Animal Shelter on Thursday January 28<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Sales Tax Measure Ordinance:**

The Council will consider the second reading of the Ordinance that will place a one-half cent sales tax measure on the June 7<sup>th</sup> Presidential Primary ballot at the February 9<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting.

### PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

#### **WWTP:**

In a previous Friday Note (12/31/15) Public Works reported that the City had received notice that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (CRWQCB) had scheduled a Public Hearing on April 21/22, 2016. On behalf of the City of Corning, Severn Trent Services has requested a Time Schedule Order (TSO) that would allow the City time to achieve testing compliance with regards to effluent limitations set by the CRWQCB. Upon approval of the TSO, the City will have the term of the new Permit (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020) to comply with the Permit requirements.

Effective January 27<sup>th</sup> the CRWQCB has approved the TSO. This is good news for the City of Corning in that the TSO allows a 5-year time span for Severn Trent Services to bring the effluent limitations within compliance of the CRWQCB standards. During this time period, the City will not be issued fines for noncompliance of effluent sample results. Kathy Stone (Severn Trent Services) has reported that the CRWQCB will still conduct the Public Hearing in April as a matter of standard policy. The TSO issues a "Task and Timeline" schedule for the City (as the Discharger) to reach sampling compliance:

Submit and implement a Pollution Prevention Plan (PPP)	December 30, 2016
Submit Annual Progress Reports	December 1, 2016 (annually thereafter)
Submit a Treatment Evaluation Report	July 30, 2017
Submit Final Project Documents	December 31, 2018
Achieve Compliance	January 27, 2021

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 174 calls for service, a total of 40 officer reports were taken and there were 92 officer-initiated incidents, including 42 traffic stops. Officers made 15 misdemeanor arrests and 2 felony arrests, and issued 23 citations of which 12 were misdemeanors, 5 were infractions and 6 were parking-related during the period of January 27, 2016 through February 3, 2016.
