### SCHEDULES:

**January 27, 2015:** City Supervisors will be attending a 2 hour mandatory "Prevention of Sexual Harassment & Abusive Conduct Training (AB 1825) in at the City of Red Bluff Council Chambers. Managers and Supervisors are required to complete this training every two years. Fortunately, this training is provided by our JPA, Northern California Cities Self Insurance Fund, at no cost.

**February 6, 2016 Annual Chamber Dinner:** The Annual Chamber Dinner is on Saturday, February 6, 2016 at the Corning Veteran's Memorial Hall (1620 Solano St.) with the "No Host Reception" beginning at 6 p.m. followed by the dinner at 7 p.m.

### CITY MANAGER:

#### **Building Official Recruitment:**

The Building Official position is being advertised in the Corning Observer, Red Bluff Daily News, Chico Enterprise Record, and on Craigslist. The closing date for applications to be received is February 18, 2016.

#### **Licensure of Marijuana Dispensaries in Orland:**

The City of Orland directed staff to proceed with plans for licensure of Medical Marijuana Dispensaries at its January 19<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting. Orland City Council Members visited many Dispensaries and feel with adequate regulations restricting the time, place and manner of sale, the City of Orland could benefit from the additional sales tax revenue. Shasta Lake City reports \$300,000 in additional sales tax revenue as a result from the Dispensary located in its City.

Both the City of Willows and Orland are pursuing a ½ cent sales tax increase as part of their November elections.

### PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

#### **Waterline Repair:**

The Public Works Crew repaired a leaking waterline located in an alley on Fairview between McKinley and Grant Streets on Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Clark Park Restroom Update:**

I met with the Corning Little League Board on Saturday, January 16<sup>th</sup>. At that time I shared with them information I plan to present to City Council upon confirmation of construction costs. The options presented were:

1. Demolish the existing building and reconstruct a replacement building; or
2. Remodel the existing building which will include the two ADA Compliant restrooms.

The Corning Little League Board didn't specify one option over the other they just wanted the restrooms updated.

**Public Works Director Meetings & Training:**

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 187 calls for service, a total of 31 officer reports were taken and there were 108 officer-initiated incidents, including 57 traffic stops. Officers made 12 misdemeanor arrests and 2 felony arrests, and issued 20 citations of which 8 were misdemeanors, 9 were infractions, 1 was a felony, and 2 were parking-related during the period of January 13, 2016 through January 20, 2016.
