### **HOLIDAYS:**

**Presidents' Day:** Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup> City Hall, the City Finance Department, and the City Corporation Yard (Public Works) will be closed.

### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **City Manager's Department Meeting:**

I will be out of the office February 6-10<sup>th</sup> attending a City Manager's Conference.

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Landscaping Contract:**

Council authorized the Public Works Department to seek proposals for the Landscape and Maintenance Agreements at the January 24<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting. I would like to thank Assistant Public Works Director Steve Lindeman, Fire Dispatcher Daymon Schlereth and Councilmembers Linnet and Dickison for their assistance and input during the Agreement's scope of work revision.

Proposals are scheduled to be opened on February 22<sup>nd</sup> and presented to Council for Award on February 28, 2017.

#### **Toomes & Loleta Avenues:**

Public Works Crewmembers were patching potholes in this area today. City Engineer Ed Anderson will be preparing a cost estimate to make repairs to these severely dilapidated roads.

#### **Tehama County Multi-Jurisdiction Mitigation Plan Update:**

Tehama County Flood Control & Water Resource Manager Ryan Teubert received four proposals from Consultants interested in assisting Tehama County, and the Cities of Corning, Tehama and Red Bluff in the planning update of our Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan. The existing plan was approved in 2012 and is required to be updated every five-years. Ryan Teubert of Tehama County, Dawn Grine of the City of Corning and Carolyn Steffan of the City of Tehama participated in the grading process. The four consulting firms ranked as follows:

1. Tetra Tech, Inc.; Oakland, CA
2. Dynamic Planning + Service; Oakland, CA
3. Michael Baker International; Ontario, CA
4. GHD Inc.; Eureka, CA

Mr. Teubert will now present the grading results to the Tehama County Board of Supervisors. Once an Agreement is in place, the four combining jurisdictions will move forward with the Plan update.

**Kaufman Building:**

City Engineer Ed Anderson and Building Official Dan Redding will be conducting a walk-through inspection of the now empty lot. A "punch-list" will be provided to the Demolition Contractor of City Building requirements for continued clean-up and of repairs to damaged City property such as the sidewalks and the alleyway.

**Thank you:**

Public Works Crewmembers Troy Grootveld and Wayne Jobe were called out this past Sunday to clear debris that washed up next to the Hwy 99W and Toomes Avenue bridges. Officer Ferguson provided traffic control. Thank you gentlemen for your weekend service!

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 208 calls for service, a total of 41 officer reports were taken and there were 90 officer-initiated incidents, including 37 traffic stops. Officers made 11 misdemeanor arrests and 2 felony arrests. Officers issued 16 citations, of which; 11 were misdemeanors, 2 were infractions, and 3 were parking-related during the period of January 18, 2017 through January 25, 2017.

**Community:**

In a collaborative effort between Tehama County Sheriff's Office, Corning Police Department, Tehama County Health Services Agency, Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency, and the Tehama County Department of Education, a kiosk has been placed in the lobby of the Corning Police Department for secure disposal of unused and/or unwanted medications. This kiosk is now available to the public during Police Department lobby hours 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., 7 days a week.
