### SCHEDULES:

**January 27, 2015:** City Supervisors will be attending a 2 hour mandatory "Prevention of Sexual Harassment & Abusive Conduct Training (AB 1825) in at the City of Red Bluff Council Chambers. Managers and Supervisors are required to complete this training every two years. Fortunately, this training is provided by our JPA, Northern California Cities Self Insurance Fund, at no cost.

### CITY MANAGER:

#### **General Fund Budget:**

Based on using 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2015 sales tax revenue to predict total sales tax revenue for the fiscal year, the City can expect to receive approximately \$120,000 less than budgeted. General Fund reserves will be reduced by \$565,966 this fiscal year to \$536,846. From June 30, 2015 to June 30, 2016 reserves will decrease by 51%.

Fuel sales tax provides 58% of General Fund revenue. The U.S. Energy Information Administration anticipates retail U.S. diesel and gasoline prices to remain low through 2016. Further concerning is the new Pilot Truck Stop in Orland, as this will undoubtedly reduce sales tax revenue for the City.

A General Fund budget update will be given to the Council at the January 12<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting.

#### **Restore Program:**

I met with Tara Cory from the Restore Program, an eighteen week intervention program for youth. The Program proved to reduce recidivism 35% in Michigan and will be piloted in the south County. The Restore Program is looking for interns to spend approximately four hours per week with a youth over an eighteen week period. If you are interested, please contact taracory@gmail.com.

### PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

#### **Water Leak:**

A water main leak was identified on Sunday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> at the intersection of Solano and Marguerite Streets. Public Works was able to make repairs on Thursday with the assistance and support of Severn Trent Services, the Corning Police and Fire Departments.

**Public Works Meetings:**

FEMA will be hosting a workshop at which they hope to gather information regarding risks and hazards in our local community and surrounding areas. This meeting will be held on January 13, 2016 from 1:30-4:00 p.m. at the Tehama County Agriculture Department Conference Room, 1834 Walnut Street, Red Bluff.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 158 calls for service, a total of 31 officer reports were taken and there were 84 officer-initiated incidents, including 50 traffic stops. Officers made 8 misdemeanor arrests and 1 felony arrest, and issued 17 citations of which 8 were misdemeanors, 8 were infractions, and 1 was parking-related during the period of December 30, 2015 through January 6, 2016.
