#### **Martini Plaza:**

Trent Construction has completed the repairs for Martini Plaza. Public Works Equipment Mechanic Chris Demo is currently constructing a metal gate that will lock and secure the building after hours. Upon completion and installation of the gate, the chain link fencing on Solano Street will be removed and the Park will be opened to the public.

#### **Rodgers Theater:**

Workers from Salt Creek Conservation Camp have imported fill into the Theater to enable the forming/pouring of more concrete for the Theater floor. A group of Volunteers also helped with this venture. Forms will now be made for concrete pours on the both the east and west side walls.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 163 calls for service, a total of 33 officer reports were taken and there were 123 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 14 misdemeanor and 6 felony arrests, 47 traffic stops and issued 38 citations of which 4 were felony, 26 were misdemeanors, and 8 were infractions during the period of December 31, 2014 through January 2, 2015.
