Fire Chief Martin Spannaus remains on vacation and is scheduled to return on July 15th.

CITY MANAGER:

Corning Community Park:

Work continues on Phase 1 of the Park. Julie Johnson of the Corning Observer asked to view the site and take some photos on Wednesday. I accompanied her to the site.

Ed and Tom Phelps are consulting with staff and putting together the plans for Phase 2 of the Park Project.

Wood Waste Site:

Staff members from the California Department of Recycling (CalRecycle) were onsite this week completing some trenching and soil sampling at the former burn-dump site. Abel Martinez of CalRecycle called Thursday afternoon to let us know they had completed their field work. He said they'd prepare a report that should be available in 6 to 8 weeks. The report could include recommendations for additional closure treatment for the site.

You may recall that we recently collected water samples from the Animal Shelter well. We provided them to our testing lab in Redding. We received the first result-regarding coliform bacteria. **No coliform bacteria was present.** That's good news. We understand the remaining sample results will likely not be in until early August.

Solano Streetscape Project:

I've been working on the PowerPoint presentation that we'll present to the City Council regarding the Solano Streetscape Improvement Project on July 23rd. We'll publish an ad in the paper to invite the public to attend the meeting.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Safe Routes to School:

Tom Williams has the rolled curb placed on Fig Lane. It really shows how wide Fig Lane will be once the asphalt is finished. There will be a slight delay with PG&E moving a pole. Tom Williams will be able to work around that pole until PG&E gets the pole moved.

Corning Community Park:

Trent Construction has begun placing colored shotcrete into the Skate Park bowls. This is a pressurized way of placing the concrete into the forms for the walls (almost like a swimming pool). They have stated working earlier than normal because of the temperature. The closest neighbors of the park have been notified and were very supportive of the construction at the earlier hours.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 179 calls for service, a total of 27 officer reports were taken and there were 75 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 10 misdemeanor and 7 felony arrests, 45 traffic stops and issued 15 citations of which 2 were felony, 10 were misdemeanors, and 2 were infractions during the period of July 3, 2013 through July 10, 2013.
