CITY MANAGER:

New Baby Girl for City Manager:

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Streetscape Project Update:

The Contractor is in the process of reconstructing the 4th, 5th and 6th Street intersections and has already begun to pour the stamped concrete crosswalks. He anticipates paving Solano Street between 3rd and 6th Streets on July 27th & 28th. Once the paving is complete, he will stripe this same area, including the re-striping of Solano Street between 6th and West Streets.

Trent Construction has submitted a payment request which is currently being inspected and will be presented to Council at the July 26th City Council Meeting.

Clark Park Restrooms:

Corning Little League (CLL) previously provided the City with a proposal to demo the existing concession/restroom building and reconstruct a new building using material donations and Volunteers to perform the work. City Staff met with CLL on June 8th to review the list and it was determined at that time that CLL would provide Staff with a further defined list as there are a few components of their proposal that will require contracted Prevailing Wage work. Once I receive the revised proposal from CLL, I will prepare a Staff Report for City Council.

Drought Conditions:

July 5, 2016 I attended a Tehama County Drought Task Force Meeting. Tehama County Flood Control and Water Resource Manager Ryan Teubert informed the Cities of Corning and Tehama (small water systems) via email *"that after reviewing the May 9th Executive Order (B-37-16) issued by the Governor of CA and accompanying fact sheets it appears that the prior conservation requirements for small suppliers have been lifted with the exception of completing the once a year report"*.

However the Order does call for agencies to update their temporary emergency water restrictions and transition to permanent – long term improvements in water such as using water more wisely and eliminating water waste.

I will consult with the City Attorney regarding our current Ordinance No. 660 declaring the City of Corning a "Stage Two" drought condition in accordance with our City Municipal Code.

Farmers Market:

The Corning Chamber of Commerce will be hosting its annual Farmers Market every Thursday beginning June 9th through August 18th from 5 – 7:30pm held at the North Side Park (1414 Colusa Street, Corning).

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 197 calls for service, a total of 43 officer reports were taken and there were 72 officer-initiated incidents, including 27 traffic stops. Officers made 17 misdemeanor arrests. Officers issued 29 citations, of which; 20 were misdemeanors, 3 were infractions, and 6 were parking-related during the period of July 6, 2016 through July 13, 2016.
