CITY MANAGER:

Meeting with 3CORE:

On Tuesday, June 21st I will be meeting with 3CORE, the Corning Chamber of Commerce, and a member of the marketing team from Rolling Hills Casino in regards to enhancing economic development in the City of Corning.

FY16/17 Budget:

The FY 16/17 budget and associated Resolution will be presented to Council on Tuesday, June 28th for possible adoption.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Farmers Market:

The Corning Chamber of Commerce will be hosting its annual Farmers Market every Thursday beginning June 9th through August 18th from 5 – 7:30pm held at the North Side Park (1414 Colusa Street, Corning).

Solar installation at the WWTP:

Wednesday, June 15th began the transformer upgrade located at the WWTP. ICR Electric, Inc. Brian Bibby working in partnership with PG&E completed the upgrade project at about 11:00 am on June 16th. Severn Trent Services Project Manager Kathy Stone reported that Severn Trent Services Staff worked 24-hours to assure that the project went well and that there were not any issues with the operation of the plant.

A second transformer will need to be installed but its installation process will not take nearly as long to complete. Mr. Bibby has predicted 4-hours for work and the plant would be operating from stand-by generators.

WWTP Staff:

Severn Trent Services Staff have introduced their latest “new hire” at the plant. Former staff member Travis Barber accepted a promotion and transferred to the Willows WWTP about a month ago. Severn Trent Services has recently hired Bryan Manzo as their new lab technician.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 184 calls for service, a total of 28 officer reports were taken and there were 121 officer-initiated incidents, including 47 traffic stops. Officers made 11 misdemeanor arrests and 5 felony arrests. Officers issued 27 citations, of which; 12 were misdemeanors, 4 were infractions, 9 were parking-related, and 2 were animal-related during the period of June 8, 2016 through June 15, 2016.

CART (Child Abduction Response Team):

The Corning Police Department CART members (part of a three-county team consisting of law enforcement, social services, etc. from Shasta, Siskiyou and Tehama counties) are participating in a CART exercise for National Certification on Wednesday and Thursday, June 15-16.
