SCHEDULES:

John Brewer: Will be off work Thursday afternoon and all day Friday. During this absence, Police Chief Don Atkins will be the Acting City Manager during this time.

John Stoufer: Will not be in the office on Thursday or Friday of next week.

CITY MANAGER:

Skate Park Event:

There is a scheduled "Skate Day" event at the Skate & Bike Park for Saturday, June 21st between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. This will be a competitive event with five separate Age Divisions, Best Trick competition, and will include Bands/Music, Food and Raffles. The Police and Fire Department have been notified. Public Works will have a Maintenance Worker available to assist.

Waterline Extension:

County Environmental Health Director Tim Potanovic and I met with County Planning Director and LAFCo Executive Director Sean Moore in Red Bluff to discuss the potential Waterline Extension Project. We wanted to present some updated information regarding the number of affected dwellings, since the number (11) differed from our initial LAFCo application that put the number at seven (7). At the time of the application we didn't know one of the subject parcels was improved with a four-plex.

Sean will review the LAFCo Conditions of Approval to see if the matter needs reconsideration or if he can simply make an administrative decision regarding the minor change.

Final Budget Document/Resolution:

Roy Seiler was in town on Tuesday to assist with the finishing touches on the FY 2014-2015 Budget and Resolution. He also helped out on the Appropriations Limit Resolution and Investment Policy Staff Report.

Lunch with Managers:

I attended a luncheon meeting with County CEO Bill Goodwin, Red Bluff City Manager Rick Crabtree and County Superintendent of Schools Larry Champion in Red Bluff on Thursday.

Meeting with H & CD:

Our Grants Consultant JoAnn Anders has scheduled a meeting between herself, John Stoufer, and Patrick Talbot, an H & CD Economic Development Representative and I on Tuesday, July 8th at 10:00 a.m. in Sacramento. The primary subject will be technical assistance relating to the City's need of infrastructure improvements to attract new businesses to Corning.

Northside Park Kiddie Pool Flooring:

We've received a number of complaints regarding the bottom of the Kiddie Pool at Northside Park. Apparently the plastered surface is cracking and peeling and cutting/hurting kids' feet. We've started collecting proposals to do the plaster repairs and will present a staff report seeking urgent funding for that purpose.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 183 calls for service, a total of 34 officer reports were taken and there were 110 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 13 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests, 63 traffic stops and issued 26 citations of which 0 was a felony, 14 were misdemeanors, 9 were infractions, 1 was animal-related and 1 was parking-related during the period of June 11 through June 18, 2014.
