HOLIDAYS:

July 4th (Friday): City Hall will be closed in observance of Independence Day.

SCHEDULES:

John Brewer: Will be out Thursday afternoon and all day Friday. During my absence, Police Chief Don Atkins will be the Acting City Manager.

John Stoufer: Will not be in the office Tuesday or Friday of next week.

EVENTS:

Olive Festival: 25th Annual Corning Olive Festival will be held at Woodson Park, 2062 Peach Street on August 22nd and 23rd.

CITY MANAGER:

Kiddie Pool Repairs:

Assistant Public Works Director Steve Lindeman is collecting proposals for replastering repair of the Kiddie Pool floor at Northside Park. Once we have a minimum of three we will select the lowest qualified bid and order the work completed.

Waterline Extension:

We heard from County Planning Director and LAFCo Executive Director Sean Moore regarding our previous LAFCo application for the proposed waterline extension. Sean requests that we get a "Will not oppose annexation" letter from the property owner with the differing number of dwelling units. I have asked Engineer Amanda Beam of Broadbent to contact the owner (Mr. & Mrs. Lopez) to gauge their willingness to sign such a letter. If they'll sign the letter, LAFCo review of the matter will not be necessary.

Meeting regarding Waste Discharge Requirements at Airport:

Assistant Public Works Director Steve Lindeman and I met with Severn Trent Staff at the WWTP (Wastewater Treatment Plant) to discuss the details of the stormwater discharge sampling requirements at the City's Airport. The sampling and reporting is required by the Regional Water Quality Control Board to monitor stormwater discharges that could negatively affect the waters downstream of the site. I signed a report detailing our findings for this fiscal year.

Rodgers Theater Floor Construction Plans:

I emailed and received a response from draftsman Bob Metzger who is preparing the construction plans for the replacement of the Theater floor. He relays that he expects to have something for us to review next week.

Meeting with H & CD:

Our Grants Consultant JoAnn Anders has scheduled a meeting between herself, John Stoufer, me and Patrick Talbot, an H & CD Economic Development Representative on Tuesday, July 8th at 10:00 a.m. in Sacramento. The primary subject will be technical assistance relating to the City's need of infrastructure improvements to attract new businesses to Corning. (Repeat from last week.)

Corning Community Park Phase 2:

Staff has collected proposals and will go ahead with the purchase of playground equipment, the pedestrian bridge, and lighting equipment in accordance with the Council authorization at Tuesday's (6/24/2014) City Council meeting.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 202 calls for service, a total of 37 officer reports were taken and there were 116 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 12 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests, 57 traffic stops and issued 26 citations of which 1 was a felony, 14 were misdemeanors, 7 were infractions, 1 was animal-related and 3 was parking-related during the period of June 18 through June 25, 2014.
