### **SCHEDULES:**

### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **Rodgers Theater Restoration:**

Concrete was poured Saturday morning. This was the last section of the auditorium floor remaining to be placed. An "Open House" event at the Theater is scheduled for Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. (directly following the City Council Meeting). This event is being held to share with the community the progress accomplished to date on this restoration. At the same time, staging the opening event demonstrates to the State Department of Parks and Recreation the significant progress made toward completion of the Theater rehabilitation. Live Music by the North Fork Band and refreshments (courtesy of Linda Lima) will be provided.

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Water:**

Public Works did routine maintenance of the water system, concentrating on well houses and meters.

#### **Sewer:**

Public Works cleared two sewer lateral blockages. They excavated a main line collapse on El Verano and have temporarily fixed it. It will be permanently fixed when new parts arrive.

#### **Parks:**

Public Works has been busy getting Clark Park ready for opening day of Little League. They are also working on Yost Park for an upcoming American Legion Softball tournament. Although the area is currently still closed to public use, a window was broken in the Lennox Fields bathroom; the damage has been repaired by the Maintenance Crew.

### **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 222 calls for service, a total of 37 officer reports were taken and there were 32 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 13 misdemeanor and 0 felony arrests, 19 traffic stops and issued 13 citations of which 0 were felony, 12 were misdemeanors, 1 was an infraction during the period of March 11, 2015 through March 18, 2015.

#### **Personnel:**

Our newest Police Officer, Matt Portillo began his employment with the Department on Sunday, March 15, 2015.
