### CITY MANAGER:

#### **Tehama County Air Pollution Control District Indirect Source Review Meeting:**

On March 21<sup>st</sup> I attended the Tehama County Air Pollution Control District Indirect Source Review Meeting to discuss allocating \$50,000 of Rule 2:11 funds to augment Community Development Block Grant dollars to correct shoulder and roadway flooding, install ADA compliant sidewalks, curb ramps and crosswalks, and designate highly visible bike lanes on Grant Street (near the High School) in Los Molinos. We approved the allocation.

#### **Restore Program Graduate Recognition:**

On March 21<sup>st</sup> Gary Strack and I met with Tara Cory from the Restore Program to discuss a method to recognize Graduates of the Program. With parental permission, Graduates will be recognized with a certificate at a City Council meeting.

#### **Lucero Olive Oil:**

On March 23<sup>rd</sup> I met with Liz Tagami, General Manager of Lucero Olive Oil, regarding where they would like to see their business in the next five years and their vision for the City of Corning. Liz and I plan to meet regularly to discuss and create action measures as to how we can work cooperatively.

#### **Training:**

I will be attending the Tehama County Prosperity Symposium on March 25<sup>th</sup>, and on March 30<sup>th</sup> a training on how to work in Indian Country.

### PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

#### **Downtown Streetscape Project:**

A pre-construction meeting has been set for 3 p.m. on March 31<sup>st</sup>. The meeting will include City Staff, the City Engineer, Trent Construction and project Subcontractors. Local Business Merchants have been invited to an informational meeting scheduled to begin at 5 p.m. that same day. Both meetings will be held in the Corning Council Chamber Room.

#### **Sewer Main Repairs:**

At the March 8, 2016 City Council Meeting, Council authorized sewer main repairs to be made at the Corning Chevron located at 820 Hwy 99W. Walberg Inc. has informed Public Works that they will begin work on March 29<sup>th</sup> at 7 a.m. Traffic will be allowed to pass through the intersection with minimal delays. Traffic control will be provided. Walberg Inc. has indicated that this project will take less than 2 days.

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

### **Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 197 calls for service, a total of 36 officer reports were taken and there were 96 officer-initiated incidents, including 46 traffic stops. Officers made 19 misdemeanor arrests and issued 30 citations of which; 22 were misdemeanors, 4 were infractions, 1 was animal-related, and 3 were parking-related during the period of March 16, 2016 through March 23, 2016.
