CITY MANAGER:

FY 2017/18 Budget:

Roy Seiler and I met on Thursday May 18th to continue work on the FY 2017/18 Budget and Capital Improvement Program. Measure A funds will allow the City to more adequately fund Capital Improvement, but the City will not be able to fully "catch up" to where it needs to be in one fiscal year.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 195 calls for service, a total of 23 officer reports were taken and there were 102 officer-initiated incidents, including 28 traffic stops. Officers made 9 misdemeanor arrests and 3 felony arrests. Officers issued 17 citations, of which; 8 were misdemeanors, 6 were infractions, 2 were felony, and 1 was parking-related, during the period of May 10, 2017 through May 17, 2017.
