CITY MANAGER:

FY 2016/17 Budget:

Roy Seiler and I met on Thursday, May 19th to continue work on the FY 2016/17 budget. There may be changes needed to the Landscaping and Lighting District budgets that will require Proposition 218 noticing.

City Manager's/Administrator's Meeting:

Tehama County Chief Administrator Bill Goodwin, Red Bluff City Manager Rick Crabtree, and I met on May 19th to discuss common issues we are facing and how to improve our jurisdictions.

Solar Installation at the Wastewater Treatment Plant:

Solar array installation is proceeding. Ecoplexus requested off hours access to the plant. Due to the nature of the work and the ramifications if the plant were to go down, Severn Trent and City Staff are concerned about access to the plant without Severn Trent Staff present. Ecoplexus is approved to complete the mechanical installation of the panels during off hours using a side access road, as they do not need access to the plant for this.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Downtown Streetscape Project Update:

Section 1; south side of Solano Street between 3rd and 4th Streets

- Concrete work is completed
- Traffic/side street parking will resume temporarily until street paving begins
- Palm trees will be planted later on in the project
- 4th Street intersection on the south side of Solano will remain closed

Section 2; south side of Solano Street between 4th and 5th Streets:

- Concrete work is partially complete
- Contractor anticipates opening the Banner Bank driveway early next week
- 5th Street intersection on the south side of Solano will remain closed

Section 3; south side of Solano Street between 5th and 6th Streets:

- Currently installing electrical conduit and the irrigation waterline
- 6th Street intersection on the south side of Solano will close this week and will remain closed

The Contractor does not expect Solano Street to be entirely closed due to intersection construction until July. The closure will encompass 3rd Street through to 6th Street. Updates will be provided throughout construction.

City Pool:

The City Pool is due to open on June 6, 2016. The pool schedule of operation and fees are available on our website at www.corning.org

Corning Airport:

The EAA (Experimental Aircraft Association) will be sponsoring its annual "Kids Fly Free" at the Corning Airport on Saturday, May 21st. The Knights of Columbus will be serving a pancake breakfast from 8 a.m. until 10 a.m. for a cost of \$5. Volunteer Pilots will be ready by 9 a.m. and the event will last until noon. Kids from the ages of 8 through 17 can fly for free, but an adult must be available to sign the registration application.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 233 calls for service, a total of 42 officer reports were taken and there were 107 officer-initiated incidents, including 41 traffic stops. Officers made 18 misdemeanor arrests and 4 felony arrests and issued 33 citations, of which; 1 was felony, 20 were misdemeanors, 7 were infractions, 3 were parking-related, and 2 were animal-related during the period of May 11, 2016 through May 18, 2016.
