CITY MANAGER'S NOTES:

Grand Re-Opening-Liquor Cabinet:

Budget Preparation:

We continue to work on preparing the budget. Roy Seiler did not come in this week. We felt that having him come in next Monday and perhaps Tuesday would be best. That way he will be here to close out the books for May. We'll then have eleven full months' data to use to support our budget projections.

Planning Consultant Contract Extension:

We plan to present the Planning Consultant Contract Extension staff report on June 11th. By then we expect we'll have completed the rewriting requested by the State Dept. of Housing & Community Development. City Attorney Jody Burgess is preparing the revised contract.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Corning Community Park:

With the current pace of Trent Construction, Staff decided to conduct a subcontractor meeting with Sierra Landscape on Thursday, May 30th. Attendees were Tom Phelps (Landscape Architect), John Stoufer (Planning Director), Terry Hoofard (Building Inspector), Steve Lindeman (Assistant Public Works Director), Patrick Walker (Public Works Director), Craig Gurney (Sierra Landscape) and Kendel Trent (Trent Construction).

The City wanted to ensure timeframe cohesion for each contractor to work with each other and iron out any schedule conflicts. The outcome will have the Landscaper at the Park in about a month.

Corning Jr. Rodeo:

The Jr. Rodeo is scheduled at Clark Park for this upcoming weekend. The Jr. Rodeo Association has done a great job fixing up the rodeo grounds. Public Works has picked up tree branches for them and brought them bleachers from the High School. On Monday Public Works will take the bleachers back to the High School.
