CITY MANAGER:

Negotiations with Waste Management:

Waste Management indicated they would be providing a revised proposal to the City by November 17th as part of our franchise hauling agreement negotiations.

City Christmas Party: Friday, December 15th:

The City's Christmas Potluck Party will be held at the Fire Hall Annex on Friday, December 15th from noon to 1:30 p.m. Service Year Awards will be presented at this time. We hope to see everyone there to celebrate the holidays, our employees, and another successful year in the City.

Fire Chief Retirement Party:

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department is hosting a retirement party for Fire Chief Martin Spannaus on December 8th at 6 p.m.

Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) Hearing:

As Finance Director for the City, I will be conducting a TOT Hearing on November 30th with a local Operator that is appealing late penalty assessments. If after I make a decision the local Operator disagrees with the decision, they may appeal to the City Council.

Fire Engine Purchase:

It was determined the procurement process led by NPP.gov complies with public procurement laws. Financing for the Fire Engine is being researched.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Lead Water Sampling at Local Schools:

Earlier this year the State Water Board distributed information to all water system owners that service K-12 schools that it would be encouraging all schools (Statewide) to test their drinking water for lead. The information received indicates that the State will be issuing a permit amendment to all community water systems that it will be the responsibility of the public water system to cover the costs associated with collecting, analyzing and reporting the results to the Division of Drinking Water and the school.

The Corning High School and Elementary Districts requested the testing and samples were collected on October 17th. The City received the results with all locations testing negative for lead.

Street Sign:

The street signs located at Solano and Marguerite are becoming unreadable due to fading. The replacement signs are on order and will be installed as soon as they are received.

Hometown Christmas Parade December 2

Solano Street between Houghton Avenue and 3RD Street will be closed on Saturday, December 2, 2017 beginning at 5:30 p.m. for the Hometown Christmas Parade. The staging will take place on Yolo and Houghton prior to the event.

Training:

Public Works Director Dawn Grine will be out of the office December 4th through the 8th for a Federal Aid Series training course hosted by Caltrans and located in Santa Ana California.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 189 calls for service, a total of 19 officer reports were taken and there were 58 officer-initiated incidents, including 41 traffic stops. Officers made 7 misdemeanor arrests. Officers issued 12 citations, of which; 5 were misdemeanors, 2 were infractions, and 4 were parking-related, and 1 was unclassified during the period of November 14, 2017 through November 21, 2017.
