#### **Creek Maintenance:**

The Salt Creek Conservation Camp Crew is in town completing annual streambed cleaning of debris and vegetation. They began work this week at Jewett Creek east of the Animal Shelter near Carona Avenue and will be working their way east. Areas of work will include Blackburn Moon Drain, Jewett and Burch Creeks.

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

### **Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 165 calls for service, a total of 29 officer reports were taken and there were 58 officer-initiated incidents. Officers made 10 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests, 35 traffic stops and issued 14 citations of which 5 were infractions, 9 were misdemeanors during the period of September 12-September 19, 2012.

### **Personnel:**


The Police Department is continuing to accept applications for a Dispatcher/Clerk.
