### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **Tehama County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update:**

Ryan Teubert of Tehama County Public Works has informed the City that Tehama County has been awarded funding in the amount of \$112,500 to complete an Update of the Tehama County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan which is set to expire in October of 2017. The original Hazard Mitigation Plan was completed in 2011-2012 and included the Cities of Tehama, Corning and Red Bluff. The City of Corning adopted a Resolution authorizing the adoption of the Tehama County Hazard Mitigation Plan on November 13, 2012.

Over the next few weeks the County will be taking the necessary steps to hire a consultant to facilitate the update process. Once the Consultant is hired, this process will require staff time from City Law Enforcement, Fire, Planning, and Public Works during steering committee meetings, and participation with review of the document. This time will be used along with County grant/contract administration time to make up the 25% (\$37,500) match required by the grant. The initial steering committee meeting will likely occur during October/November with meetings continuing for several months.

City participation and subsequent adoption of a Countywide Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, rather than the City generating/updating our own document as was done in 2014 will generate a huge savings to the City.

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Paskenta Water:**

Public Works was contacted by the Paskenta Water District on August 29th informing the City that surface water levels have dropped. They anticipate drawing water from the Corning water system and hauling it to Paskenta within the next few days.

#### **Clark Park Restroom Update:**

The Restroom/concession stand at Clark Park is now completely 'torn down and the debris has been taken to the Red Bluff Landfill.

#### **Water Leaks:**

Two water leaks were reported to Public Works and repairs have been made this week. One was on Fig Street near Houghton Avenue and the other on West Street near Fig Street. Neither leak was in the city main, both were lateral service lines.

**Zombie Run:**

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:****Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 162 calls for service, a total of 33 officer reports were taken and there were 98 officer-initiated incidents, including 49 traffic stops. Officers made 11 misdemeanor arrests and 5 felony arrests. Officers issued 27 citations, of which; 12 were misdemeanors, 2 were felony, 8 were infractions, 1 was animal-related, and 4 were parking-related during the period of August 24, 2016 through August 31, 2016.
