### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **City Manager Returns from Maternity Leave:**

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Landscape Agreement:**

The Public Works Department has extended the Bid Opening date for the Landscape and Maintenance Agreement. The original call for bids did not clearly state the Prevailing Wage requirements associated with the scope of work within the agreement. The bid opening has been extended to October 20<sup>th</sup>. Notification has been forwarded to Contractors from a Vendors list. Bidders packages are available at Corning City Hall or on our website; [www.corning.org](http://www.corning.org).

#### **PG&E Announcement:**

PG&E has informed the Public Works Department that they have scheduled a "Planned Electrical Service Interruption" near the corner of Solano and Edith to make repairs in a location near that intersection. The planned interruption is scheduled for October 1st 12:00a.m. - 4:00a.m. The traffic signal may or may not be affected, but will blink red lights during that period of time should the traffic light intersection be within PG&E's area of repairs.

#### **Little League:**

Drafter Max Ramierz submitted a DRAFT Plan for the concession/restroom building at Clark Park. The City Engineer and Building Official returned the plans with comments.

#### **Leaves:**

It is still a little early yet, but we have been asked about leaf pick up throughout the City. The Public Works Department will not begin leaf pick up until the beginning of November unless Mother Nature dictates any earlier. **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 259 calls for service, a total of 36 officer reports were taken and there were 53 officer-initiated incidents, including 17 traffic stops. Officers made 14 misdemeanor arrests and 2 felony arrests. Officers issued 20 citations, of which; 12 were misdemeanors, 2 were infractions, 4 were animal-related, 1 was parking-related, and 1 was unclassified during the period of September 21, 2016 through September 28, 2016.
