4. Report by Tehama County Librarian Jessica Hudson.

Tehama County Librarian Jessica Hudson reported that the County Preliminary Budget does not reflect any new financial cuts to the Library Budget. Jessica also reported on several other positive notes for the Library. One being the upcoming computer based reading program that is going to be made available to children called BookFlix. This program originates from the State. Also, Book Clubs have been started up in both the Red Bluff and Corning Branches; paperback books will be cataloged; an "Author Visit" program has been sponsored by the Department of Education. The Department of Education and the Tehama County Librarian are hoping to focus on home-schooled children who would not have the opportunity to attend the Author Visit at their local schools.

County Librarian Hudson reported that a recent Bunco Fundraiser generated \$915 that will help support the Summer Reading Program. The Fact or Fiction book store located in Red Bluff donated 30 boxes of books and 8 shelving units. The shelving units will remain at the Red Bluff Library and the 30 boxes of materials will be distributed to all three County Libraries.
