D. REVIEW OF RODGER'S THEATRE:

City Manager Kimbrough informed the City Council that he had met with John Cummings, Theatre Concessionaire to discuss the current situation at the Theatre and Mr. Cummings had voluntarily offered to close the Theatre on Monday, October 2, 2006. Mr. Kimbrough also informed Mr. Cummings that only packaged food could be sold until the Theatre closure.

Mayor Strack informed the Council that he, Councilor Hill, Fire Chief Robert Pryatel, and Public Works Operations Superintendent Carl Crain toured the entire Theatre with the exception of the office and ticket booth on Wednesday, October 27, 2006, this tour is why this meeting was initiated.

The Council was informed that Mr. Crain has contacted an electrician and was informed that the electrical repairs necessary to bring the building up to code and meet public safety regulations would cost an estimated \$15,000. He also informed the Council that he has arranged for a large garbage bin to begin removing debris from the Theatre. City Manger Kimbrough
