**2. Trash and Recycling Bin Enclosures: Review proposed drawing S-25 and consider a recommendation to the City Council for addition to the City of Corning Construction Specifications and Standard Details for Public Works requiring trash and recycling bin enclosures pursuant to Assembly Bill No. 341.**

Chairperson Robertson introduced this item by title and the City's Consultant Planning Director John Stoufer explained the proposal. He stated that Kristina Miller, Tehama County Sanitary Landfill Agency Manager has proposed this to eliminate as much waste as possible going to our landfills pursuant to Assembly Bill No. 341.

Commissioner Barron confirmed that this is a new drawing, there is no existing one. Commissioner Reilly stated that some of the businesses in town have similar structures as shown in exhibit A. It was also asked by Commissioners Reilly and Barron what types of remodeling would trigger this requirement? Mr. Stoufer stated that it would have to be extensive remodeling, not just painting, etc.

Commissioner Reilly moved to recommend that the City Council adopt a Resolution adding drawing S-25 to the City of Corning Construction Specifications and Standard Details for Public Works requiring bin enclosures to include an area for recycling bins. Commissioner Mesker seconded the motion. **Ayes: Robertson, Reilly, Barron and Mesker. Absent: Poisson. Opposed/Abstain: None. Motion was approved by a 4-0 vote with Poisson absent.**
