2. Update on the construction of Phase I of the New City Park.

Public Works Director Patrick Walker and City Contract Planning Director John Stoufer informed the Commission that City Staff would make the recommendation to City Council at the March 12, 2013 City Council meeting to award the Bid for the development and construction of Phase I of the Corning Community Park Project to Kendel Trent Construction. They further stated that the recommended Bid Award includes all four of the suggested Bid Additives. Mr. Walker and Mr. Stoufer further informed the Commission that the Contractor will be required to complete and submit all the required project documents prior to beginning work on the project.

Mr. Stoufer then provided the timeline for the Contractor to complete the Storm Water Prevention Plan prior to start of construction.

The Commission asked if a Groundbreaking Ceremony was planned. Mr. Stoufer stated that he would relay this question to City Staff and after discuss and receiving an answer, respond back to the Commission with their response.
