D. REGULAR AGENDA:


1. Waive the Reading of the Minutes of the March 6, 2012 Recreation Commission meeting with any necessary corrections. Commissioner Smith motioned to approve the Minutes with the following correction; to have the Minutes include the "Naming the Park Contest" and that this naming process would be taken to council for recommendation. Commissioner Shoemaker seconded the motion. **Ayes: Lauderdale, Smith, Johnson and Shoemaker. Oppose: None. Absent: Copley. Abstain: None. Motion approved by a vote of 4-0.**

2. Discussion and presentation of the Phase I Construction Plans for the New Park Ed Anderson brought the plans for Phase 1 of the New Park. Ed informed the Commission and members of the audience that the plans for the Skateboard Park were at about 99% and the Civil Plans for the park were also at about 99% complete. The New Park will hopefully go out to bid by the first of the year. There was some discussion about the City keeping the Skateboard group better informed about the different phases of the park.
